Penns Grove wins \$800,000 grant to aid development

The U.S. Commerce Department announced yesterday that it would provide \$800,000 to improve Penns Grove's wastewater treatment plant to support the development of the Riverwalk project in the Salem County town on the Delaware.

"President Bush believes one way to create jobs is to grow the economy by encouraging investments in local communities," David A. Sampson, assistant secretary for the department's Economic Development Administration, said in a statement.

He said the money would help "create more than 250 jobs and generate \$24 million in private-sector investments."- **Inquirer staff**
